If you need help to pay your mortgage, seek **FREE** assistance from a reliable source immediately. **Contact a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)-certified counselor or your mortgage company.**

FREE HUD-CERTIFIED COUNSELING

How can I find a free HUD-certified counselor?

CHECKLIST TO SPOT A SCAM

DO YOU KNOW IF THE CALLER IS LEGITIMATE?

MISREPRESENTATIONS

A caller may claim to:

- **Represent the government.**
Call 877-HUD-1515 (877-483-1515) to learn if they are HUD-certified.
- **Be a certified non-profit housing counselor.**
Contact 877-HUD-1515 (877-483-1515) to learn if the non-profit agency is HUD-certified.
- **Be calling on behalf of your mortgage company.**
Call your mortgage company or call 1-888-995-HOPE (4673) to locate your mortgage contact information.
- **Belong to your church or another familiar group.**
Make sure the caller is HUD-certified.

FALSE PROMISES

A caller 'guarantees' you can keep your home.

- The process of foreclosure prevention is too complicated for anyone to guarantee an outcome. Be careful of easy promises.

FEEES

A caller asks for payment before solving the problem.

- HUD-certified counselors are free. All housing related payments should be made to your mortgage company.

PRESSURE TACTICS

A caller pressures you to act.

- Do not sign any deeds, leases, or mortgage documents under pressure.

A caller asks you to temporarily sign over the deed.

- Once you sign over the deed you may no longer own your house but you still owe the mortgage!
