FR Y-10 Historic Reporting Changes

Reflects changes made since 1999

Date	Description
December 2009	FR Y-10 <ul style="list-style-type: none">Revised the general instructions to reference the accounting standard (FAS 167), with respect to the exclusion of reporting of variable interest entities
December 2008	FR Y-10 <ul style="list-style-type: none">Effective December 31, 2008, the Federal Reserve added a data item to the FR Y-10 to collect the tax identification number (Tax ID) on the Banking and Nonbanking Schedules.
April 2008	FR Y-10 <ul style="list-style-type: none">Effective April 30, 2008, the Domestic Branch Schedule was added to collect reportable structure information on domestic branches and offices of domestic depository institutions (including thrifts, and banking Edge and agreement corporations) that are direct or indirect subsidiaries of a top tier bank holding company (BHC), domestic branches of state member banks or banking Edge or agreement corporations that are not affiliated with a BHC.

June 2007

FR Y-10

- Effective June 30, 2007, the following reports merged into one event generated reporting form, the FRY-10:
 - Report of Changes in FBO Organizational Structure (FR Y-10F)
 - Supplement to the Report of Changes in Organizational Structure (FR Y-10S)
 - Notification of Foreign Branch Status (FR 2058)
- The aforementioned reports were then discontinued.

May 2004

FR Y-10

- Reorganized the report into separate entity-based schedules for reporting banking, nonbanking, mergers, and 4(k) investments
- Replaced the Federal Reserve System activity codes with the North American Industrial Classification System codes (NAICS) for reporting activities.

September 2001

FR Y-10

- Replaced the FR Y-6A with the FR Y-10 to reduce the burden and costs associated with this report
- Revised the structure and content of the form to make reporting by domestic and foreign banking

organizations similar

- Increased the thresholds for reporting nonbanking investments
- Reduced the types of investments to be included and streamlined the method of reporting percentage ownership of nonbanking investments
- Simplified the reporting of legal authority and activity codes
- Moved certain information on the structure of foreign investments from the FR 2064 to the FR Y-10

April 2000 FR Y-6A

- Revised form to include information collected from financial holding companies and unaffiliated state member banks on changes in investments and activities related to the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act of 1999.
