Research publications

- A Working Group formed by the Committee on the Global Financial System (CGFS) conducted macroeconomic and financial stability analyses on the <u>changing patterns and</u> <u>composition of international capital flows</u>.
- For a large sample of emerging and advanced economies, <u>Carrière-Swallow et al. (2021)</u> find evidence that a relatively more credible monetary policy regime—measured by betteranchored inflation expectations—is associated with lower exchange rate pass-through to consumer prices.
- Laurent et al. (2021) highlight the importance of the Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) - which identifies legal entities involved in financial transactions – in monitoring systemic risk in the global economy.

Research publications

- Employing supervisory data on the U.S. branches of foreign banks and their syndicated loans, <u>Correa et al.</u> (2021) show that the branches of euro-area banks suffered a liquidity shock in the form of reduced access to wholesale funding from U.S. money market funds during the European sovereign debt crisis.
- Using administrative data <u>di Giovanni, et al. (2021)</u> analyse the transmission of the Global Financial Cycle (GFC) to domestic credit market conditions in Turkey.
- <u>Dell'Ariccia et al. (2021</u>) argue that the rise of corporate intangible capital at the aggregate level reduces the market for commercial debt, and thus the market for bank commercial and industrial (C&I) loans, inducing banks to reallocate their lending capacity to non-C&I assets, such as mortgages.
