Later, Ponce NHS extended its services to 15 municipalities in the southern and central area of Puerto Rico. Our organization is cataloged as a housing counseling agency, HUD-Approved, which allows us to provide financial literacy (credit and budget management), as well, to train clients in first time homebuyers workshops and counseling for the foreclosure prevention. In addition, Ponce NHS has a community development department; we promote the implementation of resident's boards and community needs surveys, sponsoring community activities and projects. Ponce NHS is an active member charter of NeighborWorks America and is certified by the Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI). It has the State Tax Exemption Section 1101 (4) of the Internal Revenue Code of Puerto Rico and the Federal Tax Exemption 501 (C) 3. Our office is located in downtown Ponce, which has been our home for more than 21 years. Ponce NHS has a long trajectory of successful projects. These achievements have allowed us to diversify and expanded our services, which has implied an increase our staff. In the beginning Ponce NHS had a 4 member's staff, now, we have a total of 15 employees. Therefore, the space has fallen short and limits the possibility of holding concurrent educational workshops and/or serving participants one on one effectively.

This Center will provide all the services and workshops from our several Programs, Projects and activities in just one place. This will be extremely cost effective, and will offer our clients and program participants, the assurance about finding all the assistance and support that they need in a specific, more comfortable and spacious location. For this reason and we are running out of space. It has been a challenge for us to continue helping our communities with such a limited area for us to do our job effectively. Our main goal is to provide a comfortable space to our clients, program participants and employees, to enhance our staff performance, and make the visit to our offices, the best experience to all.

In addition, as a non-profit organization, receive donations (such as equipment and materials) and due to being short in space, we have nowhere to store them. In addition, it is HUD regulation to be able to serve our clients privately and now, because of the staff increase, we often must move employees to different areas around the office, to be able to provide privacy to the client. On the other hand, our current location lacks parking space and is in desperate need of an area that people can leave their cars safely. This is something that we want to improve immediately. By having a more spacious parking area, we can provide a safe and comfortable environment for our clients and employees. Also, this will be helpful in many ways because we usually rent vehicles to serve communities of low- or moderate- income that are distant from our main office and this will provide us the space needed to accommodate them.

We want to improve our services and impact as many communities as we can, which means that our main location is a critical part of the process. Ponce NHS is looking forward to moving into a closed branch or a potential location, in the city of Ponce P.R., to upgrade our facilities and services. Our current business office is in a property that was a former house and was remodeled into an office space.
