- **The School Outreach Initiative** brings New York Fed staff into your classroom to give an accessible presentation on such topics as the role of the Federal Reserve, its history and monetary policy.
- **It serves to complement** your school's social studies, civics, economics, and history and/or business curriculum.
- **Visits are free** and can be scheduled Monday through Friday during the school year and should be requested at least one month in advance.
- **Choose from four interactive lessons:**

  - Advanced Introduction to the Federal Reserve
  - History of the Federal Reserve
  - Introduction to Monetary Policy

This program is designed to reach students in schools that may benefit from resources to teach economic literacy, including Title I high schools and community colleges.
