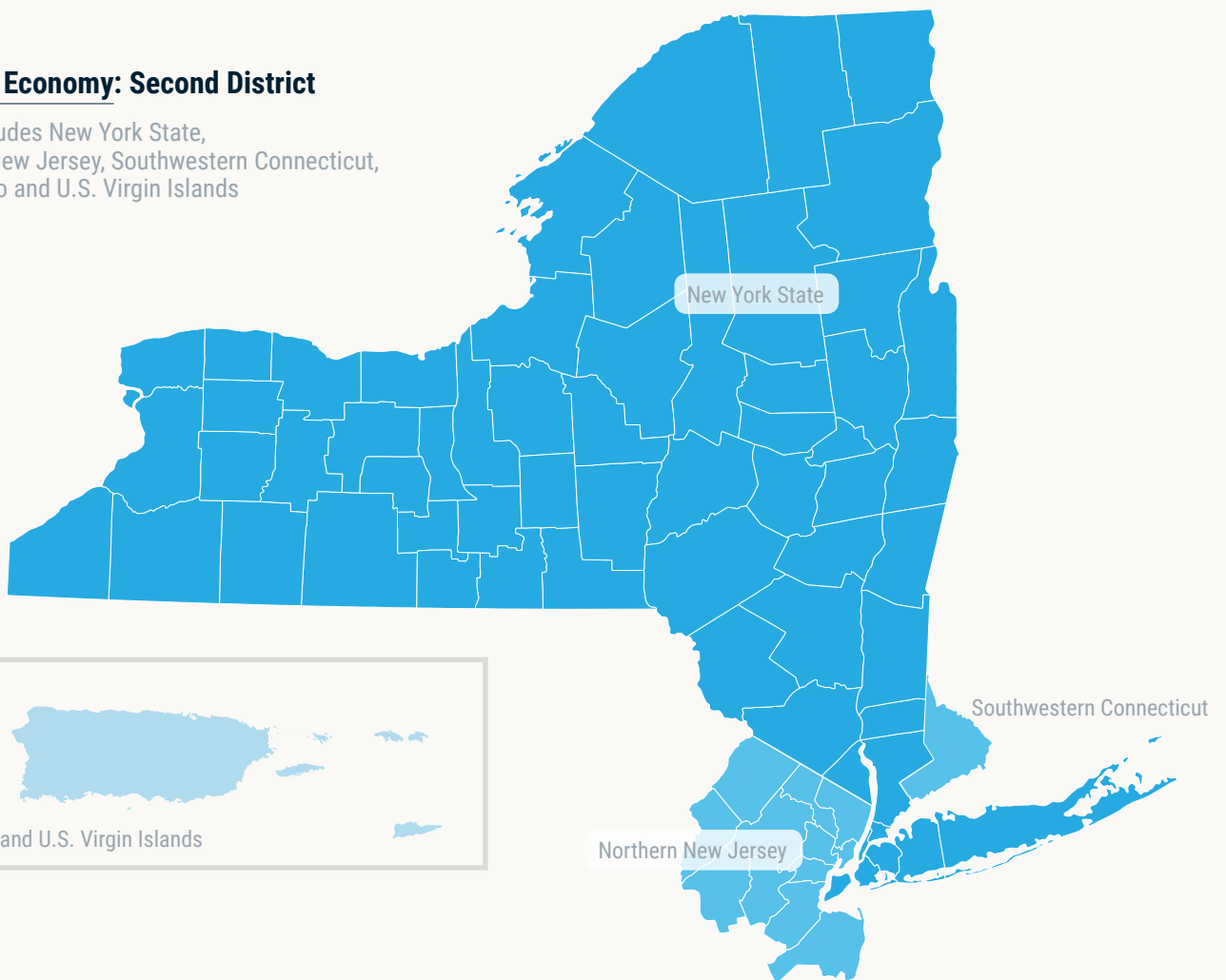

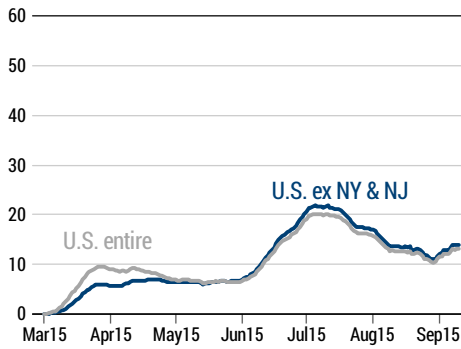


COVID-19 Case Growth by Region – Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands

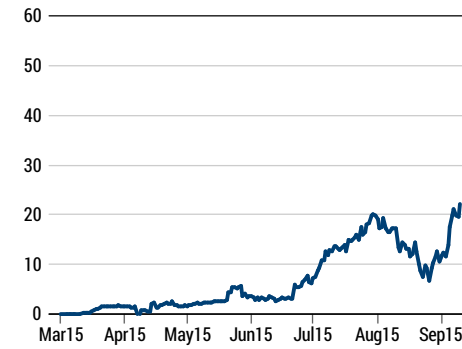
Seven-Day Average of Daily New Confirmed Cases Per 100,000 People

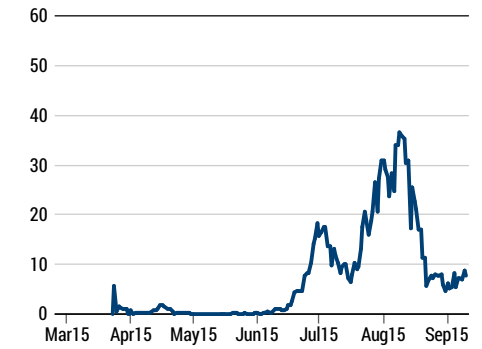

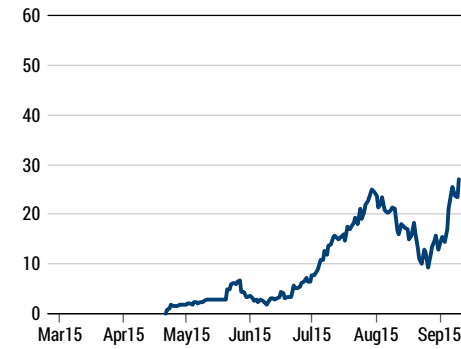

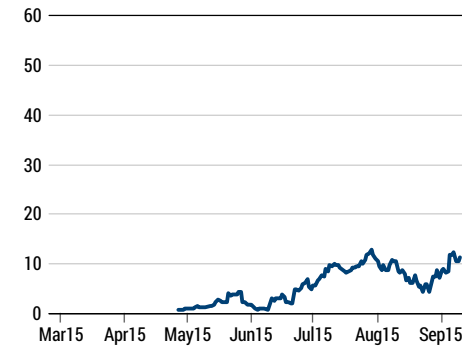

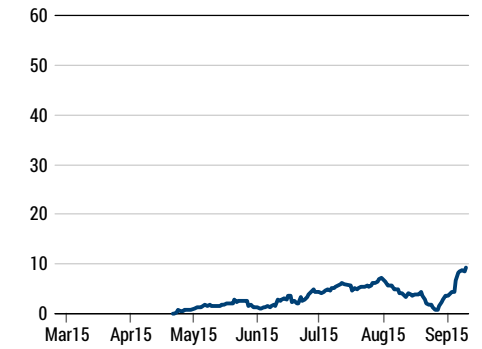

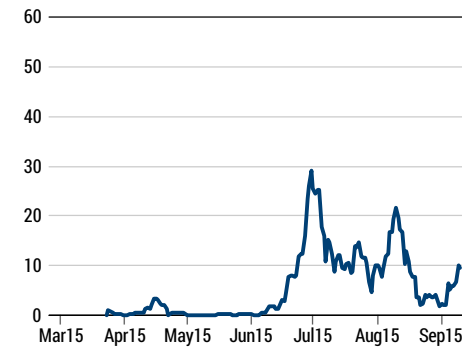

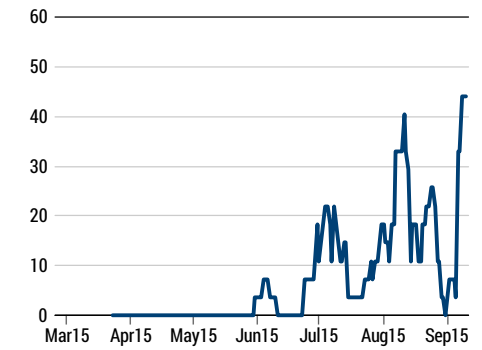
