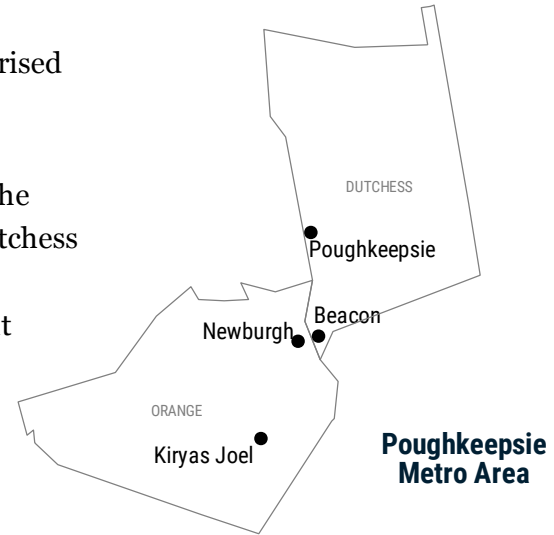


# Poughkeepsie Metro Economic Indicators

With a population around 700,000, the Poughkeepsie metropolitan area is comprised of Orange and Dutchess counties. Orange County is the larger of the two, and it has grown particularly rapidly over the last 10 years, and its population is relatively young. Dutchess County had been a major tech manufacturing hub in the 1970s and 1980s when it was anchored by the presence of IBM. However, the Dutchess manufacturing sector has been hit particularly hard in recent decades, seeing an employment decline of roughly 70 percent since 1990. More recently, employment growth in the Poughkeepsie metro area has been most robust in the leisure & hospitality and transportation & warehousing sectors. Academic institutions like Vassar, Marist, and Bard Colleges, as well as West Point and the Culinary Institute of America, have been strong contributors to the economic growth of the metro area, though employment growth in the education sector has slowed since the pandemic.

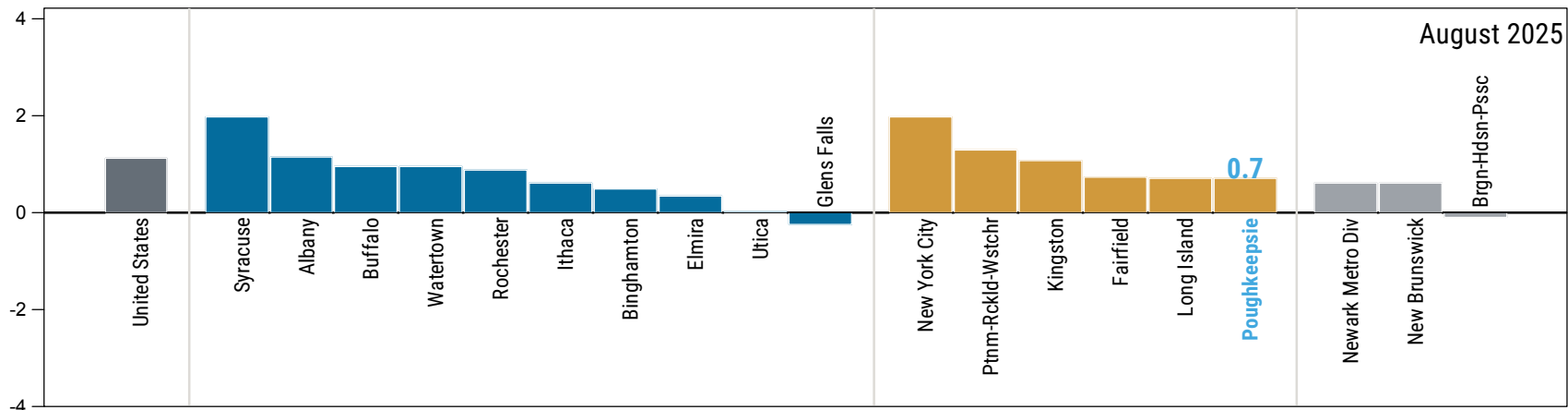

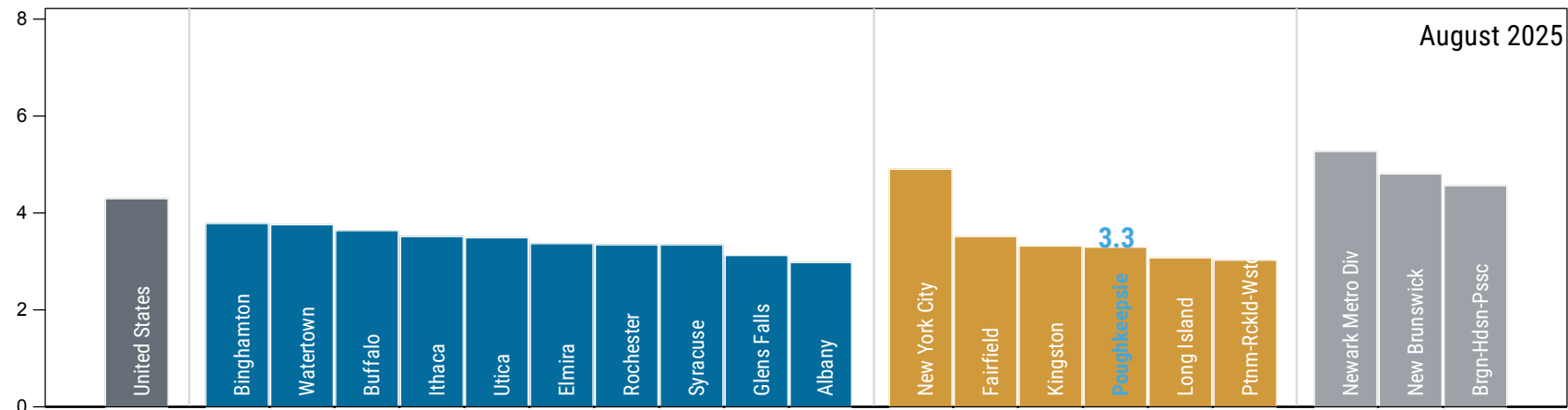

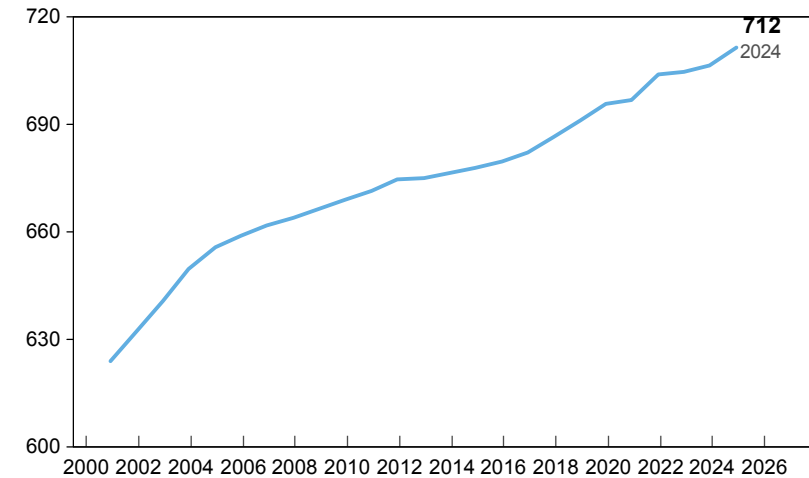

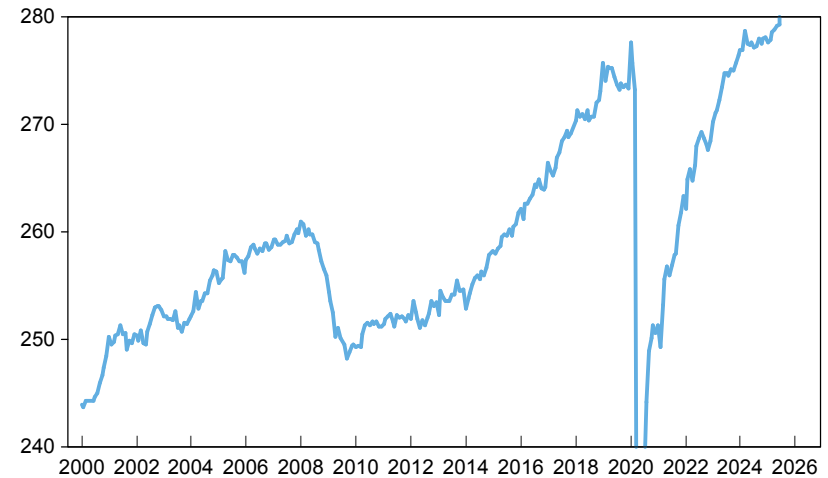

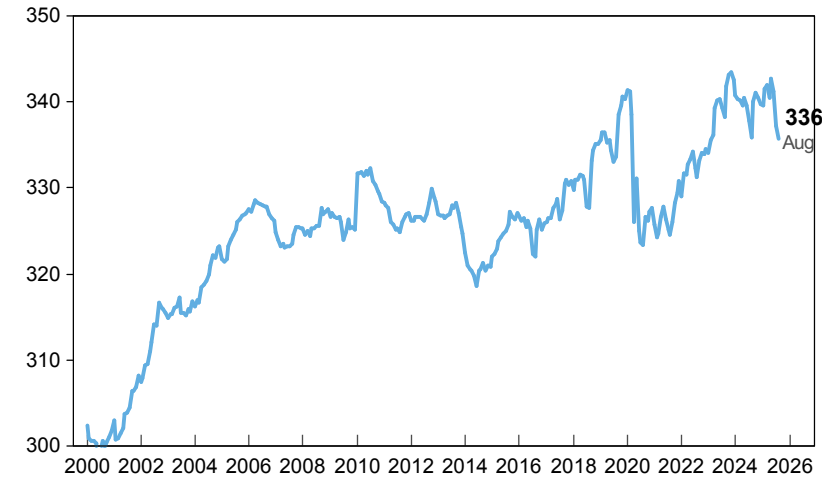

## Labor Force

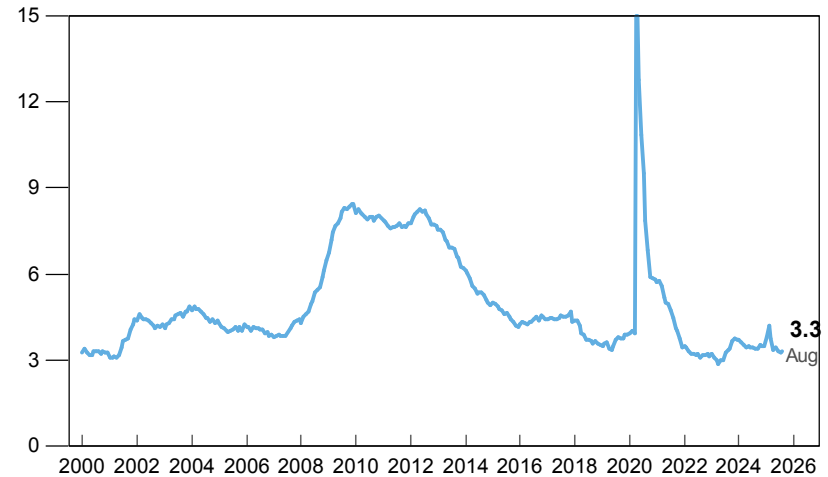

Percent

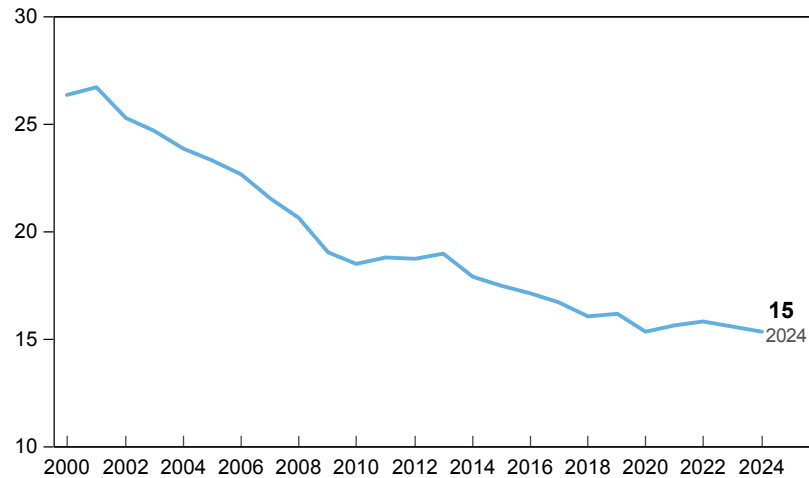

## Manufacturing Employment

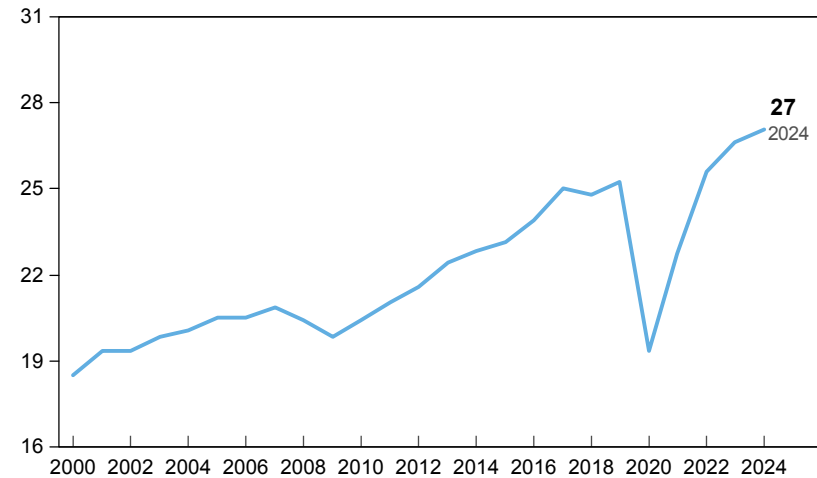

## Leisure & Hospitality Employment

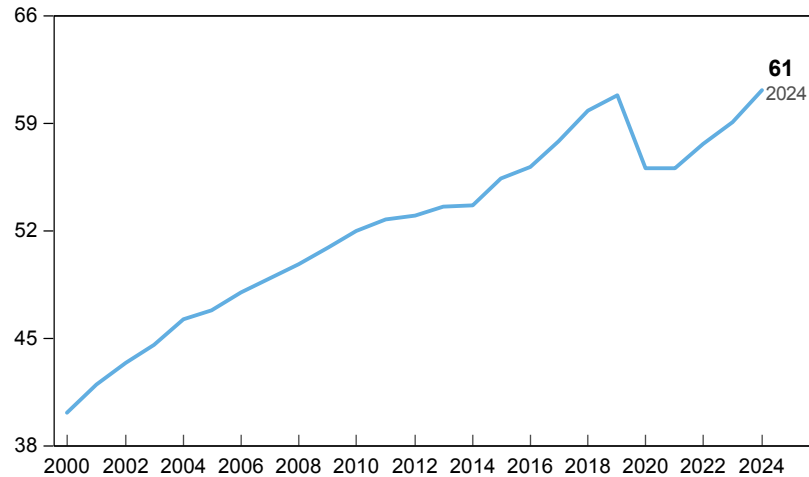

## Education & Health Employment

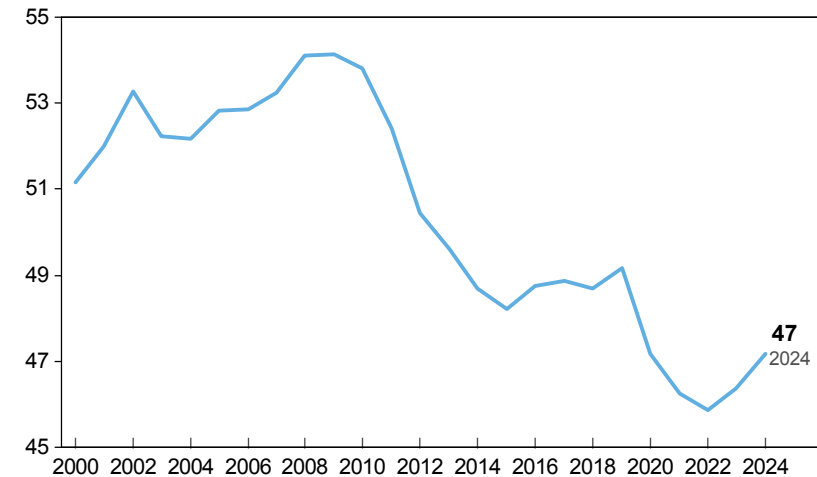
